## ACADEMIC PATHWAY FOR ROOTS TO BOOTS PARTICIPANTS

- 1. Completion of Roots to Boots Certificate
  - a. Enter directly into the workforce
  - b. Continue on at Cincinnati State
- 2. Take 6 additional credit hours (two courses: Woody Plant Materials and Herbaceous Plants) to earn Cincinnati State Landscape Technician Certificate for 28 credit hours.
- Students may then decide to complete a 2 year degree Associates of Applied Business Degree in Landscape Horticulture. This would require 40-44 additional credit hours to graduate.
  - a. The reason for this range is that 4 credit hours is required co-op work experience. Some, or all, of this requirement may be fulfilled by work history through KCB.
