SERVICE LEARNING

Participate in our ***Growing Green Habits*** service learning program! Students will be trained to teach one of our classroom presentations and receive all necessary materials to present on their own. These student mentors will be matched with younger classrooms to deliver an environmental peer-to-peer message. Participating students learn about sustainability while gaining public speaking and leadership skills and a sense of confidence. It's also a great opportunity earn **community service hours!**

LOCAL ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES PROJECT

The Local Environmental Issues (LEI) project engages high school students with local ecological issues while encouraging environmental stewardship. Students are divided into groups to explore an environmental topic that includes: **WASTE, ENERGY, WATER, LAND, and FOOD**. They are provided with resources and workshops to gain skills in group dynamics, research gathering, and presenting. The quarter long project culminates in a final presentation to a panel of judges.
